THE JAMMU AND KASHMIR APPROPRIATION (No.2) BILL, 2024

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BILL

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir for the services of the financial year 2024-25.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic of India, in exercise of powers vested under the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act, 2019 as follows:—

1. This Act may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Appropriation (No.2) ⁵ Act, 2024.

Short title.

Issue of

- 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of seventy-five thousand nine hundred thirty-one crore, ninety-six lakh and ninety-nine thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2024-25 in respect of the services specified in column 2 of the Schedule.
- Rs.75931,96,99,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir for the financial year 2024-25.
- 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes specified in column 2 of the Schedule in relation to the said year.
